This online lecture course included specific information about the biology, ecology, habitat preferences, life history, and health of the Mojave Desert Tortoise as well as presentations of the threats the tortoise faces today. The course introduced how we conduct field surveys and handle tortoises (including a 30 minute video presentation of the proper way to handle desert tortoises in the field), presented advice on starting a career in field surveying, and provided an introduction to the permits and authorizations that are required from various agencies. 
